# Huddle Ministry





**Here are 4 God stories from 4 different campus huddles this semester:**

1.) **Aptos High School:** One of our student leaders who graduated last year came back to speak at a huddle and about 45 kids attended! After the huddle I had a chance to give a bible to a boy named Mark who has never had a Bible but was encouraged to start reading it and I got to pray for him. Please partner in praying with me that as he reads God's word he will encounter the living God!

2.) **Anzar High School:** At Anzar, over 50 students have been attending the huddles consistently this semester. On one of the huddle days, we did small groups and read through Ephesians 2:1-10 together. I was able to give out 4 bibles! Please pray for those students that God will stir in their hearts to read His word and go deeper with Him!

3.) **Soquel High School:** There were about 40 students who came and heard the good news last week as I had the privilege to speak about Good Friday and Easter. I brought 25 FCA wrist bands that say JESUS WON on them and encouraged the kids to wear them that week repping on campus that Jesus WON defeating sin and death and all 25 got taken! It was also so awesome to see these kids in small groups after the talk with Bibles in hand reading aloud in Luke about the crucifixion and resurrection in a public school. Praise God!!

4.) **Santa Cruz High School:** This huddle is very new and slowly growing, but the leaders have been so faithful to prepare well each week, invite people, and pray. Last Thursday, one of the student leaders and I dropped off gatorades for the baseball team with Bible verses taped to them and an

invitation to the huddle the next day. Two baseball players came to the huddle and one of them asked for a Bible at the end and said, "I need to start reading this!" There was also another girl who attended the huddle who had never been before and she also asked for a Bible and seemed eager to start reading. Please pray for these students that they will continue to come to FCA, read their Bibles, and get plugged into a local church!
