RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Hospitality Team Member:** Welcome students and tutors, build relationships, serve snacks, support transitions, and help maintain a safe and welcoming environment.
- **Snack Provider:** Provide a healthy snack by 3:00 PM and stay through 3:45 PM to serve and connect with students.

TRAINING

No Experience Needed

A church co-host or lead supervises the program and provides instructions. Hospitality Team Members support student learning and engagement but do not tutor. Snack Providers receive a list of suggested snack options.
