As a Fellowship Host, you notice people who may be new, alone, or unsure where to go, offer a warm welcome, and help them find their next step. Your presence helps people feel noticed and personally connected—not processed or pressured.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Notice and welcome people throughout the Fellowship Hall.
- Begin natural conversations and listen for what someone may need.
- Help people find the right connection and make a warm introduction.
- Share helpful notes with Niccie so she can follow up with new people.
