THE DIFFERENCE YOU MAKE

Orchestra musicians use their gifts to enrich worship during special services, often around Christmas and Easter. This large, intergenerational ensemble joins our Sunday worship team and may also present special orchestral music. Your preparation and musicianship add depth and celebration to worship.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Practice your assigned music before the first rehearsal.
- Attend all rehearsals, including Sunday morning.
- Follow the conductor and blend with the ensemble.
- Set up and put away your own instrument.

TRAINING

Musical Experience Required

Musicians must read music, follow a conductor, and prepare independently. All instruments are welcome, with parts assigned based on ability. Open to high school students and adults; younger musicians need Amanda's approval.

TYPICAL SCHEDULE

Serve:	Usually twice a year, around Christmas and Easter
Rehearsals:	Typically three per event; dates and times vary
Sunday:	90 minutes before worship
Finish:	After the second service
Commitment:	All rehearsals and both services required
