RESPONSIBILITIES

- Advance prepared slides during rehearsals and worship services.
- Follow the music and song arrangement to display the correct slide.
- Record slide corrections Amanda identifies during rehearsal.
- Stay attentive and respond calmly when the song order changes.

TRAINING

Ability to Read Music Required

Follow written music, count measures, and recognize song transitions. PowerPoint experience is not required; Amanda will show you the station and procedures.

Serve:	As needed, usually about once a month
Midweek:	September–May: Wednesdays, 6:30–7:30 PM June–August: Thursdays, 8:00–9:00 PM
Sunday:	90 minutes before worship
Finish:	After the second service
Commitment:	Both rehearsals required
