RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend as many Wednesday rehearsals as possible.
- Learn and sing your assigned vocal part.
- Follow the choir leaders and worship leader, responding when arrangements change.
- Help lead the congregation in worship rather than performing for them.
- Welcome and encourage fellow choir members.

TRAINING

No Audition Required

Members should be able to carry a tune, match pitch, sing harmony, and read music. Parts are taught during rehearsal, and choir leaders determine vocal placement. No prior choir experience is required. Open to high school students and adults.

TYPICAL SCHEDULE

Season:	September–April
Rehearsals:	Wednesdays, 6:30–7:30 PM
Serve:	About three Sundays per season
Arrival:	90 minutes before worship
Finish:	After the second service
