THE DIFFERENCE YOU MAKE

A prepared and attentive Safety & Security Team reassures people that measures are in place to respond to emergencies and maintain a safe environment. Your service helps everyone focus more fully on worship and ministry.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Arrive 20 minutes before the first service and check your assigned area.
- Monitor an assigned entrance through the end of worship.
- Assist door greeters in welcoming people and answering visitors' questions.
- Use an iPad, when assigned, to help monitor entrances during worship.
- Remain attentive and prepared to follow established emergency-response procedures.
