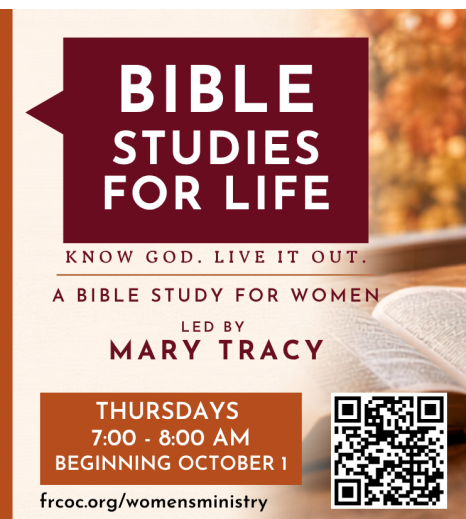

Sunday School begins today, September 13, with opportunities for children, youth, and adults between our morning worship services.

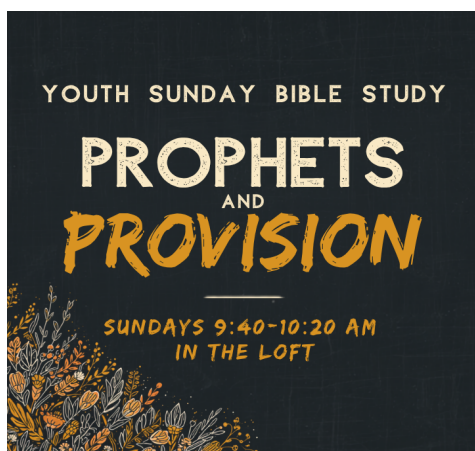
