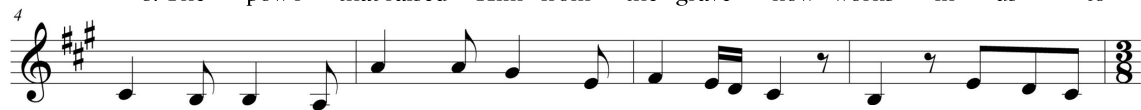
Pastor: How does Christ's resurrection benefit us?

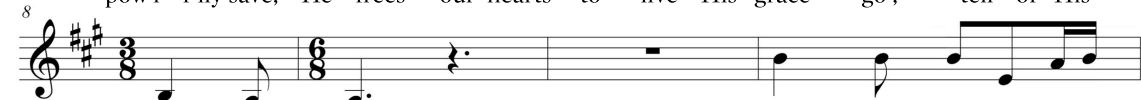
