Pastor: The Lord be with you! ✠
People: And also with you!

Call to Worship – Psalm 92

Pastor: How great are your works, O Lord!
Your thoughts are very deep!

**People: The stupid man cannot know;
the fool cannot understand this:
that though the wicked sprout like grass
and all evildoers flourish,
they are doomed to destruction forever;**

Pastor: but you, O Lord, are on high forever.
For behold, your enemies, O Lord,
for behold, your enemies shall perish;
all evildoers shall be scattered..
