Romans 12:13–18, 15:5–6

The Point: Harmony Glorifies God

1. **Romans 12:13:** *Harmony meets needs.* **Action Point:** *Meet needs of the saints and show hospitality.* What are some ways in which Trinity has met your needs or that you have seen Trinity meet the needs of others?
2. How can you become more involved in becoming aware of the needs of others in Trinity?
3. **Romans 12:14** – *Harmony blesses persecutors.* **Action Point:** *Bless your persecutors* What is a situation that you have been in or seen other persecuted? How did you emotionally handle the situation?
4. Who are individuals that you know who are openly hostile to the church? How can you create ways to tangibly serve them?
5. **Romans 12:15:** *Harmony rejoices and weeps.* **Action Point:** Weep and rejoice. How do you react with someone who is weeping? What are ways that you can be more Christlike in your care for them?
6. **Romans 12:16:** *Harmony loves the lowly.* **Action Point:** Associate with the lowly. How timid are you to truly enter the life of someone who you know is going to cost you time and energy?
7. **Romans 12:17:** *Harmony is honorable.* **Action Point:** *Give thought to do what is honorable.* What are things that you can share that you have adopted in your life that help you live blamelessly before the Lord and others?
8. **Romans 12:18:** *Harmony live peaceably.* **Action Point:** *Live peaceably with all.* How can you seek to live a life of peace with others without cowering to the emotional whims of an emotionally controlling person?
9. **Romans 15:5–6:** *Harmony glorifies God.* **Action Point:** *Glorify God with one voice.* Why do you think Paul might describe God as the God of endurance and encouragement with harmony and a unified voice is the theme of the passage?
