Greetings brothers and sisters in Christ,

We want to update you on what the Lord is doing in our ministry. As of the last letter, we stated that we were going to start the church services in March. For some time, we have been working to get electrical, water, and sewage services installed at the ministry in Villa El Salvador. However, due to the government restrictions in this area, it was not possible to get these services. The current land situation simply would not allow it. After much prayer, and talking with Pastor Walter in Villa El Salvador, we have agreed that God has changed our direction regarding the church plant there. At this time, we will not move forward with church services. However, Pastor Walter will continue doing ministry work in Villa El Salvador with his children.

A few months ago through our Bible And Breakfast tent ministry, God began showing us a need for a church in a neighboring town. Many people that came by the tent would ask us if we had a church nearby where they could come to. Seeing this need, God burdened our heart for this area and these people. We started praying that God would open a door for us if that is what he wanted. Recently, we came across a building for rent. We talked to the landlord and she was willing to give us a very good deal due to the nature of the use of the building. A few weeks ago we started a kids ministry there. We meet every Wednesday evening at this building. God has been blessing this ministry. We started with 10 children and have already grown to more than 20. On March 28th, we held an Easter program for the children. There were 19 children and 3 adults attend. Anthony gave the gospel and shared the real meaning behind easter. Also, we sang songs, played games, and did some crafts. We ended the program with a meal for everyone. We served them spaghetti, cookies, and juice. There was enough food to send "to go" plates home with the children. We are grateful for this opportunity and how God used it.

God has burdened our hearts to start our first church at this place. Thankfully, the building itself is already in great condition to do so. We are working on starting the Sunday services soon while still praying about some of the smaller details. We are also working on getting to know the community through our kids program, which will allow us to build relationships and trust. This will also help spread the word about our new church plant. Please pray for us as we follow God's leading to establish this church.

As stated last month, we were looking for a larger vehicle to use for our ministry. We are still in need of 15,000 US dollars. Please continue to help us pray about this need.
