

She came across a clear presentation of the Gospel and put her faith in Jesus! She began a daily walk with the Lord and began sharing the Gospel with her new husband. This couple decided to visit a "Christian" church for the first time in their lives and visited our church for our annual Friend Day this past Fall. Because of all the physical pain that I was going through at the time, I was unable to connect with this couple or even follow up with them for a number of weeks.

I didn't find out until recently, but her husband (the young Muslim man) trusted Christ as his Savior during the invitation of our Friend Day service! This couple has been faithfully attending our church ever since and they are wanting to get baptized as soon as my back is strong enough!

This season in which this particular testimony takes place was one of immense physical pain and even included discouraging moments for me, and yet it is absolutely incredible to see the power of the Gospel. This same couple has asked me to perform a vow renewal ceremony on their two year wedding anniversary this May as they want God to bless their home and marriage.

Please continue to pray for my health. I am slowly still recovering from my surgery. I am having my share of ups and downs. It is still hard to sit longer than 30 minutes at a time and I am slowly regaining my strength, but my arthritis is really bad and the surgically repaired disk is healing slowly. Thank you so much for the love, prayers and support.
