We landed right at the beginning of Chinese New Year celebrations here in Taiwan. Almost everything was closed for the entire week following our arrival. Thankfully, there were still a few places open that allowed us to begin setting up our apartment. At this point, our apartment is nearly fully furnished already. Missionaries John and Alisha Walz have been more than instrumental in nearly everything we have done setting up. I cannot express my gratitude enough for all that they have done to help us make this transition. They have been a huge blessing to our family and have helped us settle in quickly. There are a few more things we need to do (like buying a vehicle) that will require an Alien Resident Certificate. We have all applied for them and should be getting them within a week. I feel that we have already learned so much in so little time. We believe that the Lord has already provided the right vehicle for us through a connection that a fellow missionary has. They are holding the vehicle until we receive our certificates.
