

Please pray for these young people to grow in their faith and for the other young lady to be saved.

God has also brought a wonderful couple to our church through our outreach efforts. This couple had lived in Japan and the Philippines for many years and had come back to the states to visit relatives when the pandemic hit causing them not only to have to stay here, but also to lose their business they had established in the Philippines. They are living with the man's mother, trying to piece their lives back together when they received one of our invitations on his mom's door. They are a friendly Christ-loving couple that has been a great addition to our church.

Lastly, I want to thank all those churches that gave us a Christmas gift. Our heating bills during this long winter have more than doubled and your giving helped us greatly. Thank you for your continued prayers and support.
