Amine, one of the Bible college students, goes out with me fairly regularly to visit and witness. One of our aims has been to be more bold in sharing the gospel and not just handing a tract or church invitation. We have seen fruit from this labor. We just need to do much more of it. Christ left us here to be witnesses and make disciples so we want to make this our focus more than ever in 2023 - "Making Disciples." Pray for Amine and others in the church to be bold disciple-makers. I will say that we are truly blessed as on any given Saturday we will have a good number of young people who go out witnessing. While there are some massive challenges to church planting in the poor townships of South Africa there are also incredible opportunities to go door to door and be invited right into people's homes to openly, clearly, and boldly share the gospel with people. Just this past week for instance we went into a home and in the midst of sharing the gospel neighbors came and stood at the door to hear what the "umlungu" (white man) was up to. We are excited at the people God has added to the church but have a lot of discipleship to work on. Continue to pray for God to build Kuyga Baptist Church. We are asking God for 10 families before we have a charter service. We also need a pastor, teachers, and godly deacons in the church
