I want to start by giving praise to God for all of His many blessings. I've had a lot of health problems over the last year culminating in some pretty rough months at the end of last year and part of the start of this year. Through much prayer the Lord has really helped me get my Lupus under control and manage it to where it doesn't impact my health in such negative ways. I am a very private person and it has been hard for me to open up about things like the battles and struggles of my health, but through doing that many prayers from many of God's people have been given to help me and I just want to say prayer changes things! Thank you to all of you who have prayed and sought God on my behalf and on behalf of the people of England. I could never repay you or tell you what it means to me that God has really moved in my life in ways that I can't even understand or explain. He keeps opening door after door for us and we are excited to see what the Lord has in store for us this year!

The last quarter has been a very eventful one. In January, the Lord blessed us with a wonderful baby boy. Perrin Thatcher Newsome! We are so blessed and grateful to God for our new edition!

In February, Perrin started to develop a cough. When we travel with deputation and go through many climates and temperatures we don't think too much about coughs. It seems like one of us has a cough year round. However Perrin's cough kept getting worse so we decided to take him to the doctor. He was then taken by ambulance to a children's hospital and kept for pneumonia. He was put on oxygen and monitored. Every time they would try to remove the oxygen his O2 levels would drop and he would be put on oxygen again. After three nights and much prayer they removed the oxygen from him again and praise God his O2 levels stayed up and he was able to come home! God is so good.

As I'm writing this we have been to two back to back missions conferences and still have three more back to back missions conferences to go this quarter. We are so thankful for the opportunity to tell people about what God is planning on doing in England and are thankful that one of the churches has already taken us on for support. Please pray that the other ones will as well.

We have several more meetings coming up and I would ask each of you to please pray that we can fill up the schedule completely. One thousand four hundred and forty English people will die today and statistically every one of them will go to hell. In the summer God has opened up some doors for us out west, especially in Washington state. I ask each of you to pray that God will keep these doors open and give us many supporters from these journeys.
