### JANUARY AND FEBRUARY UPDATE

To my fellow-laborers in the Gospel,

Thank you once again for your faithful financial and/or prayer support. God has been very good these past two months, as always! We took a trip in January to Puerto Merizalde, a small town on the Pacific Coast that I have visited before, to have evangelistic services and activities for kids. As always, the kids were very receptive, and we saw God working in the hearts of new children and those I had met previously. We spent the rest of these two months working here in Valparaiso and in the surrounding towns. We also found out that Angelica is pregnant!

Elmer, a man that I met in 2024 during my first trip to Puerto Merizalde, moved to Valparaiso about a month ago to work with Dubier and us here in the church plant and to prepare for what God has for him in the future. He did not have a church with sound doctrine where he was living. We are excited to see what God is doing in his life and to see his desire to serve the Lord. He has been a blessing to have in the services here, and has gone with us on two evangelistic trips to very remote villages in the area since he arrived here. He has been cooking and selling food in the streets here to earn a living.

The Lord has been working in my heart recently about starting a Bible institute here in Valparaiso where men can be trained for the Lord's service. We are praying about the possibility of buying a small farm near the town, where up to 6 men could work and live while studying in the institute with classes being in the afternoons. Providing work and housing will be a huge blessing, because there is a shortage of work for young men here which leads to many moving to the city.

There are several folks who are attending the services regularly now. We had 15 in total on Wednesday! Dubier is doing great in leading the services and preaching once a week, and I am preaching the other service. A group from Dubier's church is planning to come at the end of March, along with his pastor, and we hope to have a baptism while they are here. The church Angelica's from has a growing Christian school. They are needing to expand the classrooms and hoping to purchase pianos and guitars to start teaching the children to play instruments as well. The pastor there there would appreciate your prayers for this endeavor.
