Hello and greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ,

I hope this letter finds you all doing well in the Lord. Thank you all for your continued prayers and support as we endeavor to serve our Lord. We couldn't do what God has called us to do without the faithful prayer and loving support of you precious folks.

These past couple of months have been busy, challenging and full of change for our family and ministry. Several months back God began to deal with my heart about a change in our ministry. I wanted to wait and make sure it was 100% the Lord before moving forward. After much prayer and counsel, we began the process of transitioning into missions helps. I simply cannot get away from this burden God has placed on my heart. Acts 16:9, "... come over and help us."

God's grace has been sufficient and so real as we prepare to leave our home and friends, and we praise His holy name for it. We are thankful for what God has allowed us to see Him do over these past 4 years in Dickinson, ND. We will never forget the souls we were able to minister to, nor will we forget what God accomplished in their lives and in ours. God has taught us some very important lessons so that we can be a greater help to missionaries across the country in the future.

The ministry God has worked in my heart, is one that is very needed. Missionaries across the United States are under a heavy burden as they try to do everything alone. We want them to know they aren't alone, and we want to go to the field with the missionary and be there during the early days of a church plant to be extra help in the fight.

We also have a desire to travel to different missionaries across the country to assist in special needs that come up and to offer encouragement as they labor for our Lord. In Mark 6, the Bible speaks of sending them forth by two and two. I don't want missionaries to have to struggle alone; I want to come along side and help them in the fight! We desire to help missionaries in the spiritual side of the ministry as well as the physical. Missionaries don't often have access to sister churches, other preachers, or friends who can help or fill in when the need arises. We want to meet that need. We are available for pulpit supply, teaching, singing, mechanical work, construction work, etc.

We have a few specific needs that we would ask you to pray with us about.

1. Support. We currently have about 30% of our needed support. This means that deputation is in our very near future.
2. House sale. We currently own our home in Dickinson and are listing it on the market by the end of September. Help us pray for a quick sale for the amount we need to get out of it.
3. Motorhome and trailer. With the nature of the ministry that lies ahead we need to be able to be mobile and self-contained year round so as not to be a burden to the ones we seek to help. I currently have a motorhome we are praying about. It has a price tag of \$60,000 and would meet the need of a home and tow rig for a trailer to haul our car in as well as the tools needed for the physical side of our ministry. We are needing a 24 foot car trailer rated for 10,000 lbs. I have found some that will meet our needs, and they have a price tag of around \$14,000.
