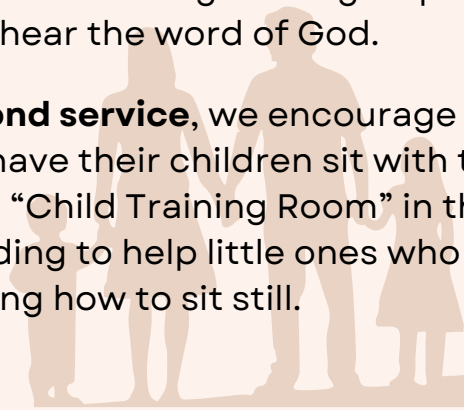
Children's Ministry

Here at CBC, we believe...

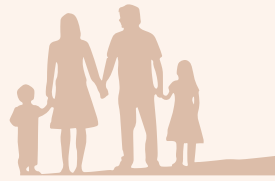
- It is the God-given blessing and responsibility of **parents** to teach their children the ways of the Lord.

...so here's what we do!

- During **first service**, we have options for 0-11 year olds to be in age level groups where they hear the word of God.
- During **second service**, we encourage families to have their children sit with them, or enjoy the "Child Training Room" in the Berean Building to help little ones who are still practicing how to sit still.



The Logistics...



I have a **0-2 year old**:

- Come to the Nursery (room straight ahead when you walk through the front door) during **first service** (at 8:30am), and pick them back up at 10:00!

I have a **3-5 year old**:

- Bring your child out to the **Annex** at **first service** (8:30), where they'll memorize the Bible to music for a half an hour, followed by their Generations of Grace lesson. Then, pick them up there at 10:00!

I have a **6-8 year old**:

- Bring your child out to the **Annex** at **first service** (8:30), where they'll memorize the Bible for a half an hour, followed by their Generations of Grace lesson. Then, pick up in the **Berean Building** at 10:00!

I have a **9-11 year old**:

- Send your child out to the **Annex** at **first service** (8:30), where they'll memorize the Bible to music for a half an hour, followed by their Generations of Grace lesson. Then, they'll be released from the **Conference Room** at 10:00!

I'd like my children to **sit through service**:

- Wonderful! We're glad you're here! You are more than welcome to all sit in main service! We all know that a bit of squirming is part of the process, but if your littles are having a particularly loud & wiggly morning, know that the **Berean Building** (outside and up the ramp) is available to you during **second service** as a training room to practice sitting quietly if that is of help to you.
