2. Read Isaiah 53:4. What did Isaiah mean when he said, “He bore our griefs” and “He carried our sorrows”? Is physical healing to be seen as a part of God’s atoning sacrifice?

3. Is God more concerned about our physical well-being or our spiritual well-being? Can you support that with Scripture?

4. Read Isaiah 53:5. What is the atonement? How important is it?

5. What three pressing things had to bring about the atonement?

6. Read Isaiah 53:6. What is the doctrine of Substitution? How important is it?

7. What are the key elements of the Gospel? In other words, what must a person know in order to get saved?

8. When was the last time you shared the Gospel with someone?

9. Is Jesus the Lord and Savior of your life? How do you know?
