“Glorifying God in Our Giving”
(Selected Scriptures)

Read Luke 16:11

1. Why should we, as God’s children, be the very best stewards of earthly money that we can possibly be?

2. How important is our attitude in our giving? What should our attitude be, based upon 1 Cor. 13:3 and 2 Cor. 9:7?

3. How can we develop such a godly attitude in our giving? (Hint: See 2 Cor. 8:1-2 and then 2 Cor. 8:5)

4. Would you rather give a gift or receive a gift? Why?

5. IF we really believed Jesus’ words in Acts 20:35, do you think the church would so often lack funds? Why is that the case then?

6. What does the following statement mean? *“Giving is not God’s way of raising money; it is God’s way of raising people into the likeness of His Son.”*

7. Do you believe that no one is too old or too young to give? Parents, why is it necessary to teach your children about finances and giving? Is that a regular aspect of your discipleship in your home?

8. What does the New Testament teach about the amount of our giving? (See: 1 Cor. 16:1-2 and 2 Cor. 9:5)

9. Can you find Scriptural support for this statement—*“Giving is only pleasing to God when it costs us something”*?
