“Churchology” 101
(Selected Scriptures)

Read Acts 2:36-47.

1. Comment on this quote from Spurgeon: *“The Church is not perfect, but woe to the man who finds pleasure in pointing out her imperfections! Christ loved His Church, and let us do the same.”*

2. Was Peter’s sermon on the Day of Pentecost what our culture would call “seeker friendly”? Why did so many people get saved after hearing it?

3. What place does the teaching and preaching of Scripture have in the believer’s life and in the life of the Church (v. 42)?

4. What is meant by the Biblical word “fellowship”? (Heb. 10:24-25 describe it well)

5. How do we know that *“the breaking of bread”* is referring to Communion and not just a church potluck? What is the reason for celebrating Communion (1 Cor. 11:26)?

6. What was the fourth priority of the Early Church? How is this priority reflected in your own life?

7. Acts 2:44-45 gives us a glimpse into the everyday family life of the Early Church. What do we find there?

8. In a nutshell, how important is Biblical leadership in a church body? What passages of Scripture give us the guidelines for selecting Church leaders? What were their qualifications?

9. As you consider your own spiritual priorities, can you say that they reflect those of the Early Church? If not, where do your priorities need to grow, or perhaps change altogether?
