

## Small Group Questions – Session 3

Reminder: These questions are just a guide! Trust the Spirit to lead your conversation and rely on your own discernment. Be sure to ask individual students questions as well!

1. What's something you were really motivated to do even though it was inconvenient? (staying up late for a game, driving far from good, waiting in a long line, etc.) What made it worth it?
2. Marquise said, "*What hung in the balance was more important than the obstacle in the way.*" What do you think that means when it comes to sharing your faith?
3. Marquise listed some obstacles: **fear, lack of knowledge, mistakes/sin, and apathy**. Why do you think those things stop people from talking about Jesus?
4. The slide said sometimes we say, "*God, I would share... but \_\_\_\_\_.*" What are some common, "but" excuses people give?
5. *2 Corinthians 5:20* says we are **ambassadors for Christ**. If an ambassador represents someone important, what do you think it means to represent Jesus at school, on a team, or with your friends?
6. Who in your life already sees the **real you** the most? What do you think they notice about your faith right now?
7. In **John 4**, many people believed in Jesus because of the woman's story. Why do you think someone's **personal story about Jesus** can be powerful for other people?
8. Is there someone in your life right now who might need to hear about Jesus or see what faith looks like?
9. What is **one simple step** you could take this week to live more boldly for Jesus? (*Invite someone to church/youth, share your story, pray with someone, start a spiritual conversation, etc.*)
10. After everything from this weekend, **what is one thing God has been showing you or challenging you to do?**
