4. In verse 7, why did God give this land to Abraham's descendants and not him?
5. In verses 7-8, what marked Abraham as a stranger, pilgrim, and believer in Canaan?
6. In verse 8, why did Abraham build altars?
7. In verse 9, where is the Negev that Abraham went?
