2. In verse 19, why do you think that Melchizedek blessed Abraham?
3. In verse 19, why is God addressed as "Possessor of heaven and earth"?
4. In verse 20, what does "Blessed be God Most High" mean?
5. In verse 20, why did Abraham give a tenth of everything to Melchizedek?
6. In verses 18-20, what do Melchizedek and Abraham's actions foreshadow?
7. In verses 21-24, what godly characteristic does Abraham display in his choice here?
8. In verse 24, why doesn't Abraham expect his allies to take no spoils as he did?
