5. In verses 2-4, who is Eliezer of Damascus?

6. In verses 4-5, how does God's promise of an heir and countless descendants for Abraham help fulfill His promises in 12:2 and 13:16?

7. In verse 6, what was Abraham's response to God's promises?

8. In verse 6, what does "accounted to him for righteousness" mean for Abraham?
