3. In verses 9-12, what does the “angel” tell Hagar?
4. In verse 9, why would Hagar “submit” when it would be difficult to do so?
5. In verse 10, what reason would God have to start the Arab nations through Ismael?
6. In verse 11, what does Ismael mean?
7. In verses 13-16, do you think that Hagar was a believer?
8. In verse 14, what does the well where Hagar and the “angel” met named Beer-lahai-roi mean?
9. What do we know about Ismael and his descendants?
