Additional questions:

1. In verse 1, what do you think it means by “the Lord visited or took note of Sarah”?
2. In verse 2, what was “the set or appointed time” that God caused the conception?
3. In verse 3, what does the name Isaac mean, and why was he named that?
4. In verses 6-7, what do you think Sarah meant by her comments?
5. In verse 8, why did Abraham celebrate when Isaac was weaned, and at what age was Isaac?
6. In verse 9, why would 17 year old Ishmael mock?
7. In verses 10-11, why was Abraham displeased with Sarah’s request?
