

Read Genesis 24:1-38 and 49 and answer questions 4-7 and 10 on pages 153-154 in Be Obedient book.

Additional questions:

1. In verses 2 and 9, what does “place your hand under my thigh” mean?
2. In verses 5-8, why wouldn’t Abraham want Isaac to go back to his homeland?
3. In verse 10, Abraham’s servant had a lot of power in Abraham’s house. Why did the servant take 10 camels with him?
4. In verse 10, where is Nahor (now Harran), and why is it special to Abraham?
5. In verse 12-14 and 26-27, what did the servant do twice in finding Isaac’s wife?
6. In verses 15-25, what do we learn about Rebekah?
7. In verses 15-31, do you think that the Lord prepared Rebekah for meeting servant?
8. In verses 28-29, why do you think that Rebekah’s brother Laban greeted servant?
9. In verses 29-31, do you think that the gold ring and bracelets made a difference to Laban?
10. In verses 33-48, why does Abraham’s servant want to tell his story to Laban?
11. In verse 49, what does “turn to the right hand or the left” mean?
