6. In verse 60, why the blessing on Rebekah, and what is the promise?
7. In verse 60, do you think that Rebekah's family expected to ever see her again?
8. In verse 62, what does Beer-lahai-roi mean?
9. In verses 64-65, why did Rebekah dismount and cover herself with a veil?
10. In verse 67, is it unusual for the Bible to speak of romantic love?
