Additional questions:

1. In verses 2, and 14-17 what problems did Isaac face even though he did as God said and stayed in the land?
2. In verses 3-5 and 24-25, what did the Lord tell Isaac as He did to Abraham earlier, and why?
3. In verses 7-11, what did Isaac lie about like his father Abraham, and why?
4. In verses 11 and 16, why did King Abimelech ask Isaac to move away?
5. In verses 12-33, how did Isaac keep peace with the Philistines?
6. In verses 19-20, do you think that Isaac's herdsmen gave Gerar's herdsmen the wells that they quarreled over?
7. In verses 20-23 and 33, what do the wells named Esek, Sitnah, Rehoboth, and Shibah / Beersheba mean?
8. In verse 23, why do you think that Isaac moved from Gerar to Beersheba when the famine ended?
