LESSON:

In Peter's first letter, he writes to young Christians who are being persecuted for their faith. Peter exhorts them to stand strong and reminds them to look to the future hope of Christ's return.

In Peter's second letter, he fights against false teachings. He reminds Christians to live in holiness and godliness. For our next meeting please read 2Peter 1:3 – 11 and be ready to discuss the following questions.

QUESTIONS FOR MARCH 10TH:

1. What are two things Paul mentions in verses 3 – 4, which God gives us to help us grow in our Christian life?

2. What are some things Peter indicates that you growing as a Christ follower?

3. Peter lists eight Christian qualities: faith, virtue, knowledge, self-control, steadfastness, godliness, brotherly affection, and love. These qualities are not just head knowledge, i.e. they will not grow by just sitting at home, meditating on them. The health of these relational qualities are measured by your real life relationships.

Please think of a time in your life, when you experienced growth in one (or more) of these relational qualities in your interactions with others.

4. Read 2Peter 1:10 – 11. What are some ways in which Peter says indicate that you will never fall, and will enter into the eternal kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ?
