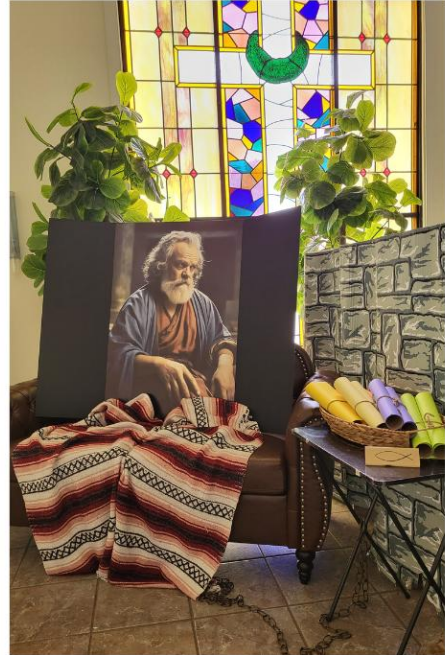

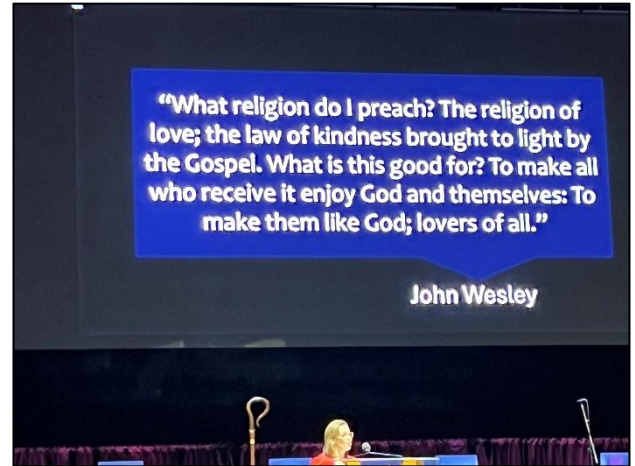
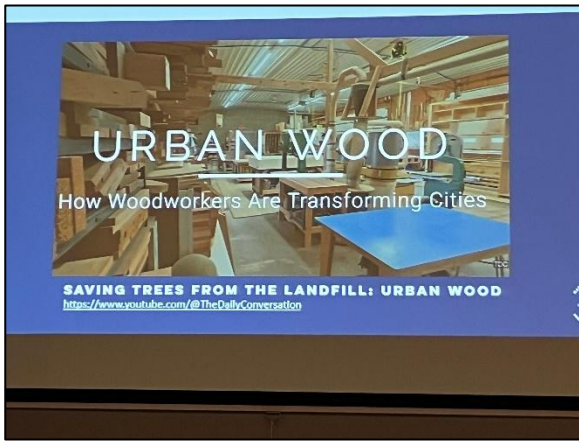




UMC ANNUAL CONFERENCE

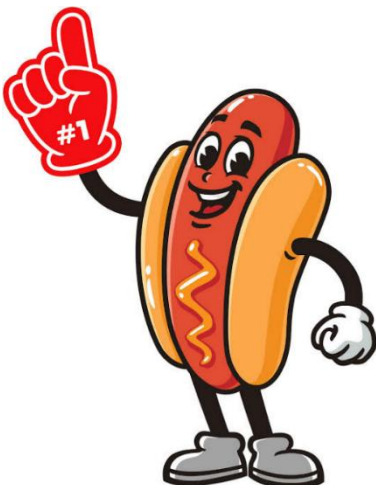

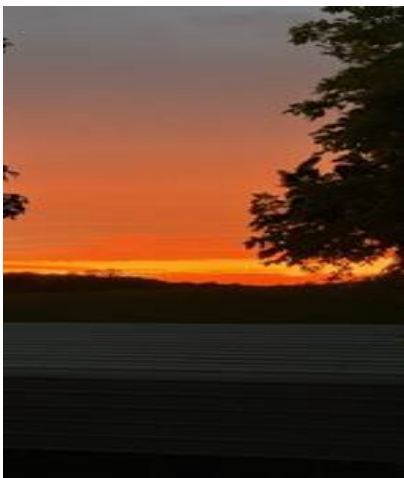
