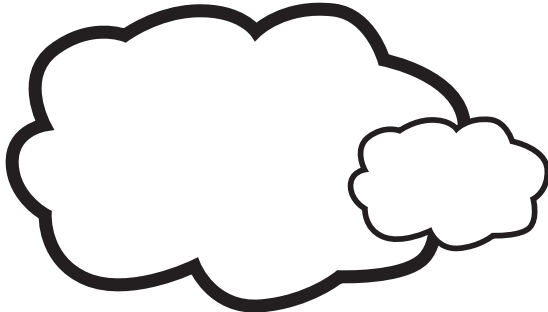


Cloudy With a Chance of Paradise

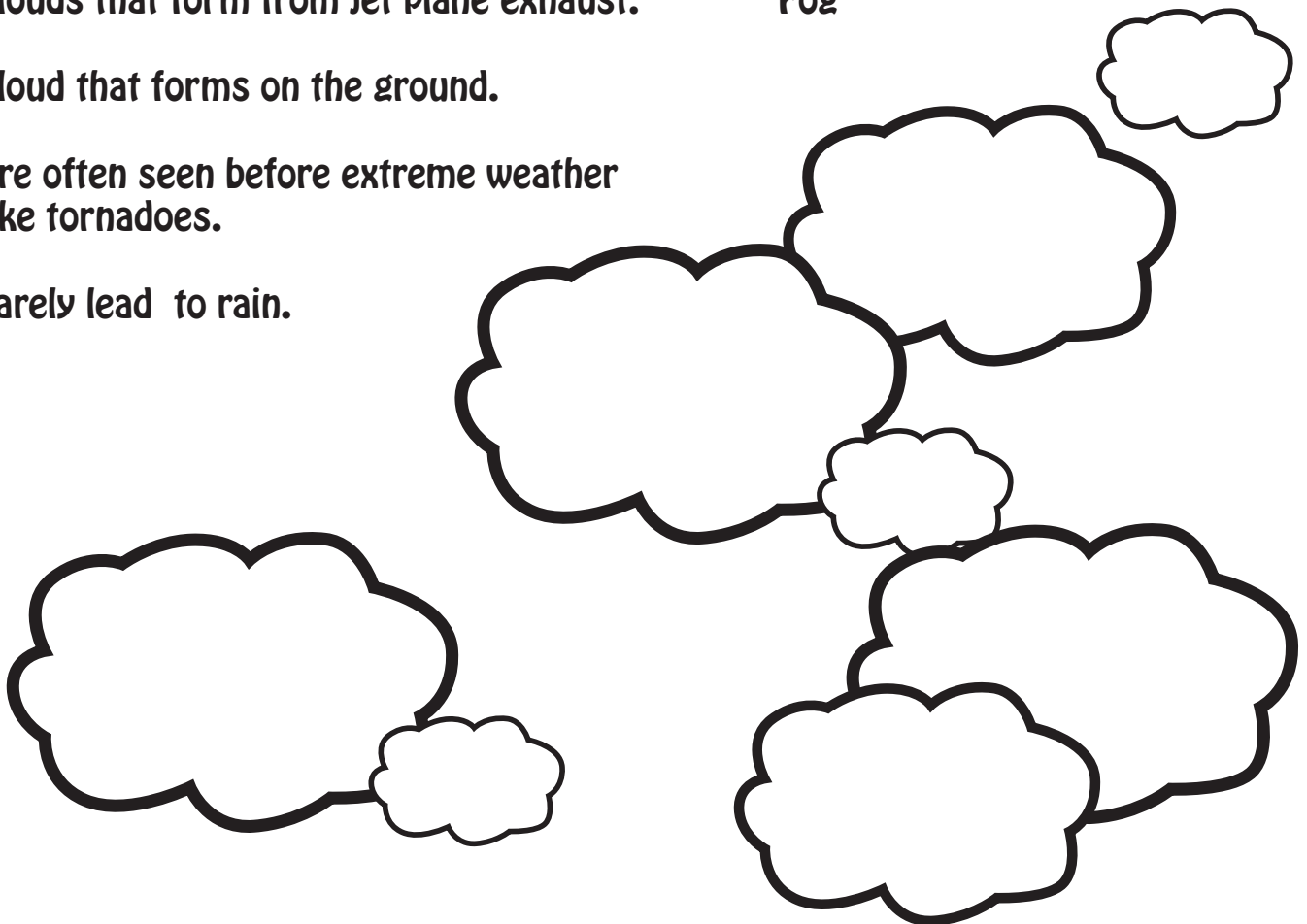

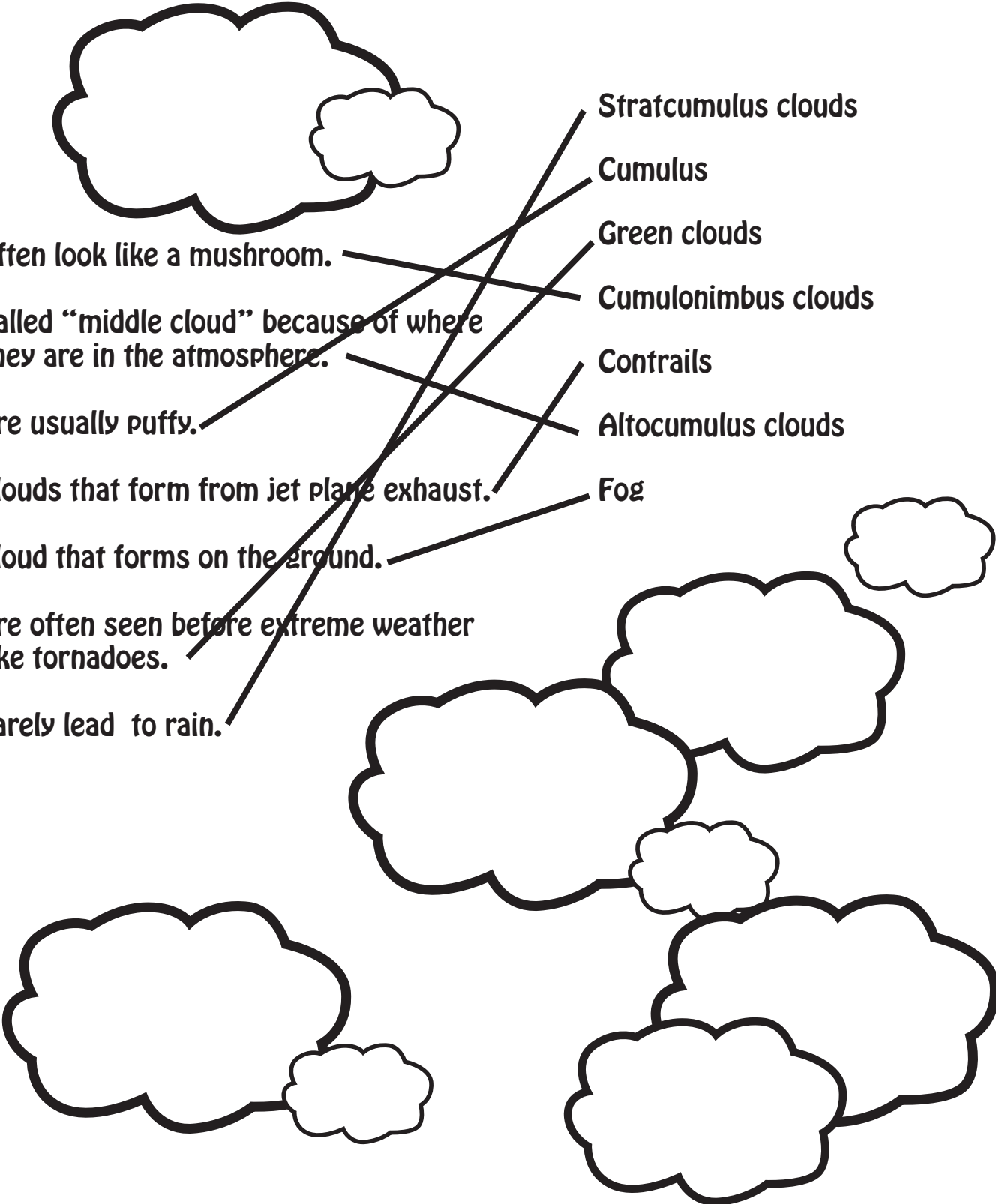
