COMMUNION

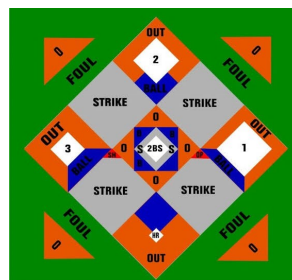
