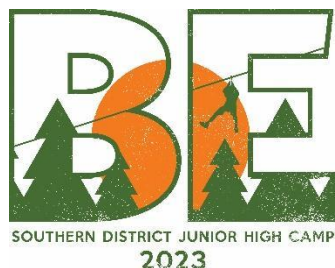


Jr. High Campers!

Dustin Mulkey, Grant Shewey & Derrick Austin will be our Program/Activities Directors. They will arrange the activities and games throughout the week and have a bunch of great games awaiting you! The Jr High Camp staff have a great week planned for you!

Here's some important stuff you need to know!

Registration is on Wednesday, May 31 from 3:00 - 4:00 pm at the chapel.

Medications: Please bring any medication to the medical health table when you get to camp to register. Medications MUST be in their original containers and will be kept with the medical health staff unless other arrangements are made directly with camp medical health staff. **PARENTS:** If you have special medical instructions, please send that information along with your child to camp or you could email the director to be put in contact with the camp medical health staff prior to camp.

Recommended Packing List: Bible, pen/pencil, pillow, bed sheets or sleeping bag, toiletries, towels, swimsuit, flashlight, bug repellant, set of clothes, shoes/sandals you can get wet/dirty, fishing equipment if you want to fish in the creek, offering money and spending money. Speaking of spending money, the "Wagon Wheel" camp store will be open daily. Don't bring your life savings, but a few dollars for pop, candy, Sky Ranch T-shirts, etc., might be helpful.

Do not bring to camp: Water balloons, pranking supplies, fireworks, or anything that's illegal. These items will be confiscated immediately when your counselor finds them.

Water shoes are recommended to swim at the riverfront (which includes the water zipline, blob, slide, kayaking, paddleboard etc.) at camp. Your water shoes must be able to stay on your feet as you do those activities and walk around the creek. Flip flops are not considered water shoes, water shoes need to have a back on them.

Appropriate Dress: **Girls** - Modest one-piece swimming suits or appropriate "tankini's" are required. No bikinis are allowed. If a counselor or staff member feels your swimming attire is inappropriate you will be asked to wear a T-shirt over your bathing suit. **Guys** - shirts are required around camp unless you are swimming. Also, please do not wear speedos. **Everyone** - all guests must wear shoes or sandals, a shirt, and dry clothes in the Dining Hall. **Please dress modestly and honor God with your dress this week!**

Cell Phones: Cell phones are allowed at camp. We recommend that if students bring a cell phone that they keep it in their cabin and use it only as needed. We want to avoid distractions and focus on God this week.

Free-time Activities: Campers will be participating in a variety of activities while at camp. The following activities are free and are available during free time: Gaga ball, volleyball, tetherball, basketball, human foosball, soccer, riverfront and the SkyLde (water slide). Also, every student will have the opportunity to ride the "Edge" zipline (Oklahoma's largest zipline – 2300 feet long) once free of charge during the free-time activities.

Extra Cost Afternoon Activities You will have an opportunity to sign up and pay for extra cost activities when you're at camp. These activities will be offered during the afternoon's free time and are one hour each. Payment for these activities can be made at the Wagon Wheel store by cash or card. Extra Cost Activities and prices are:

Skeet Shooting - \$6.25

Gelly Ball - \$11.50

Paintball - \$16.50 (Sky Ranch provides all supplies)

Frontier Zone - \$6.25 (consists of archery, BB Guns, hatchet throwing and slingshot).

Horseback Riding - \$20.25

Talent Show There will be a talent show again this year at camp. Plan your entry ahead and bring your musical instrument, costumes, skit script or anything else you need to make this an unforgettable event! **Each act will only have 1 ½ minutes to perform.**
