

OUR **GOALS**

For successful leadership growth and development we believe training and equipping needs to be practical, theological and relational.

PRACTICAL

- Support as you serve locally and develop practical ministry skills
- We encourage local and international mission
- Corporate prayer, prophecy and operating in the gifts of the Spirit
- Growing in sensitivity to the ministry of the Holy Spirit and your personal devotion to God's Word
- Other spiritual disciplines, including emphasis on reflection, journalling and scripture memory.



THEOLOGICAL

- Understanding how to dig for truth in the scriptures and how to relate faith to practice
- Understanding of the "Big Picture" of scripture and salvation past and future
- Using some key books as a basis for discussion and training in theological framework, character and how to make disciples
- Understanding how to encourage and handle prophetic words, dreams and visions

RELATIONAL

- Ministry formation and character formation
- Discipleship informally around meals

- Regular corporate prayer
- Accountability/Mentorship


TYPICAL TIMETABLE

AN Leadership college is a one-year, part-time programme to train and equip men and women for leadership in every sphere of life and especially for church planting. This will be made up of ministry experience in a local church or outreach, teaching sessions and local ministry formation groups. These are the commitments we ask for...



- Wednesday evening online sessions 7-9pm in term time
- Ministry formation groups:
 - a) some breakout time together with your small group during the online sessions
- b) other informal gatherings with your group, at least once a month preferably over a shared meal

 as a minimum, get together for a meal on the 10
 Saturdays over the year listed in the Timetable and Curriculum document.

OTHER EXPECTATIONS

This is not an academic course even though some of the teaching and suggested reading may be demanding for some. We expect everyone to:

- 1. Learn the memory scriptures we will share the list at the beginning but there is one every two weeks.
- 2. Post a simple reflection, responding to one of the sessions, on the Discussion Board online at least once a month.
- 3. Respond to at least two other participants' reflections each month.
- 4. Be present in person for at least 75% of the sessions.


Maturity
