The dates of the Wednesday sessions all together online and Saturday sessions in MFGs are below (but each MFG may want to rearrange some Saturdays to suit the group)





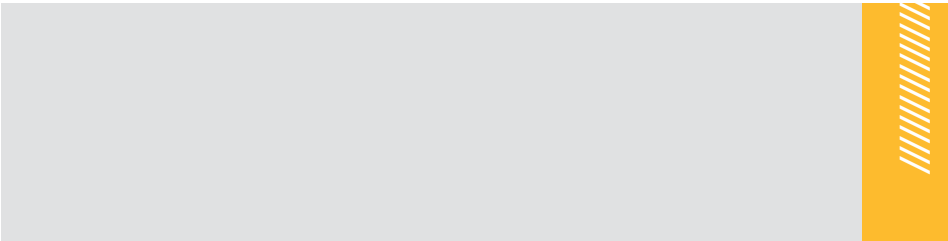
