WEEK 1: SEEING THE GLORY OF GOD

Day 1 — Ezekiel 1-2

Main Point: Everything begins with a fresh vision of God.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What stands out to you about God's holiness and power?**
- 2. How would your life change if you were more aware of God's glory every day?**

Day 2 — Ezekiel 3

Main Point: God calls ordinary people to speak His message.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What responsibility comes with knowing God's truth?**
- 2. Where might God be asking you to be a watchman?**

Day 3 — Ezekiel 4-5

Main Point: Sin always has consequences.

Reflection Questions

- 1. Are there areas where you are minimizing the seriousness of sin?**
- 2. How does God's judgment reveal His righteousness?**

Day 4 — Ezekiel 6-7

Main Point: God confronts false worship.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What competes for your affection and loyalty?**
- 2. How can you put God back in first place?**

Day 5 — Ezekiel 8-9

Main Point: God sees what others cannot see.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What hidden areas of your life need God's attention?**
- 2. How does knowing God sees everything challenge and encourage you?**

WEEK 2: THE HEART EXAMINATION

Day 6 — Ezekiel 10-11

Main Point: God's presence departs because of persistent rebellion.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What causes people to drift from God?**
- 2. How can you remain sensitive to God's presence?**

Day 7 — Ezekiel 12-13

Main Point: God warns His people before judgment comes.

Reflection Questions

- 1. How does God try to get your attention?**
- 2. Are you listening when He speaks?**

Day 8 — Ezekiel 14-15

Main Point: Idols always disappoint.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What idols are most common in our culture today?**
- 2. How can you identify subtle idols in your own heart?**

Day 9 — Ezekiel 16

Main Point: God's love remains despite our unfaithfulness.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What does this chapter teach about God's grace?**
- 2. How have you experienced God's faithfulness when you were undeserving?**

Day 10 — Ezekiel 17-18

Main Point: Every person is responsible before God.

Reflection Questions

- 1. How does personal responsibility shape spiritual growth?**
- 2. What area of your life requires repentance today?**

WEEK 3: REPENTANCE AND RENEWAL

Day 11 — Ezekiel 19-20

Main Point: God's people repeatedly forget His goodness.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What blessings from God are easy for you to overlook?**
- 2. How can gratitude protect your heart?**

Day 12 — Ezekiel 21-22

Main Point: God exposes corruption and compromise.

Reflection Questions

- 1. Where are you tempted to compromise your convictions?**
- 2. What does holiness look like in everyday life?**

Day 13 — Ezekiel 23-24

Main Point: Sin promises life but brings destruction.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What lies does sin tell us?**
- 2. How have you seen obedience bring freedom?**

Day 14 — Ezekiel 25-28

Main Point: God opposes pride.

Reflection Questions

- 1. How does pride show up in your life?**
- 2. What would humility look like this week?**

Day 15 — Ezekiel 29-30

Main Point: No earthly power can replace God.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What false sources of security do people trust today?**
- 2. How can you deepen your dependence on God?**

WEEK 4: HOPE IN CAPTIVITY

Day 16 — Ezekiel 31-32

Main Point: Pride leads to downfall.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What warnings do these chapters offer modern believers?**
- 2. How can success become spiritually dangerous?**

Day 17 — Ezekiel 33

Main Point: God still speaks to people in captivity.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What kind of captivity do people experience today?**
- 2. How is God inviting you into freedom?**

Day 18 — Ezekiel 34

Main Point: God is the Good Shepherd.

Reflection Questions

- 1. How has God shepherded you through difficult seasons?**
- 2. Where do you need His guidance right now?**

Day 19 — Ezekiel 35-36

Main Point: God promises a new heart.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What does a heart of stone look like?**
- 2. What evidence of a new heart do you see in your life?**

Day 20 — Ezekiel 37

Main Point: God brings life to what seems hopeless.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What feels like dry bones in your life?**
- 2. How can God's Spirit bring new life to that situation?**

WEEK 5: THE GOD WHO RESTORES

Day 21 — Ezekiel 38-39

Main Point: God remains sovereign over history.

Reflection Questions

- 1. How does God's sovereignty bring peace?**
- 2. What worries become smaller when viewed through God's power?**

Day 22 — Ezekiel 40

Main Point: God is preparing something greater.

Reflection Questions

- 1. Why is God's attention to detail encouraging?**
- 2. What area of your life is God still building?**

Day 23 — Ezekiel 41-42

Main Point: God's presence is holy.

Reflection Questions

- 1. How should God's holiness shape our worship?**
- 2. What does reverence for God look like today?**

Day 24 — Ezekiel 43

Main Point: God's glory returns.

Reflection Questions

- 1. Why is God's presence more important than God's blessings?**
- 2. How can you pursue His presence this week?**

Day 25 — Ezekiel 44

Main Point: Those who serve God should honor Him with their lives.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What does faithful service look like in your season of life?**
- 2. How can you better represent Christ to others?**

Day 26 — Ezekiel 45

Main Point: Worship affects everyday life.

Reflection Questions

- 1. How should worship shape your priorities?**
- 2. What changes when God is truly first?**

Day 27 — Ezekiel 46

Main Point: Consistent devotion matters.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What habits help you stay close to God?**
- 2. What spiritual discipline needs renewed attention?**

Day 28 — Ezekiel 47

Main Point: Wherever God's river flows, life follows.

Reflection Questions

- 1. Where do you need God's life-giving presence?**
- 2. How can God use you to bring life to others?**

Day 29 — Ezekiel 48

Main Point: God's ultimate plan is to dwell with His people.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What excites you most about God's future kingdom?**
- 2. How should eternity shape the way you live today?**

Day 30 — Review Reading

Read: Ezekiel 1:28, 11:19-20, 18:31-32, 33:11, 36:25-27, 37:1-14, 43:1-5, 48:35

Main Point: The story of Ezekiel is the story of a God who pursues hearts.

Reflection Questions

- 1. What has God shown you about your heart during this study?**
- 2. What specific step of obedience is God calling you to take?**
