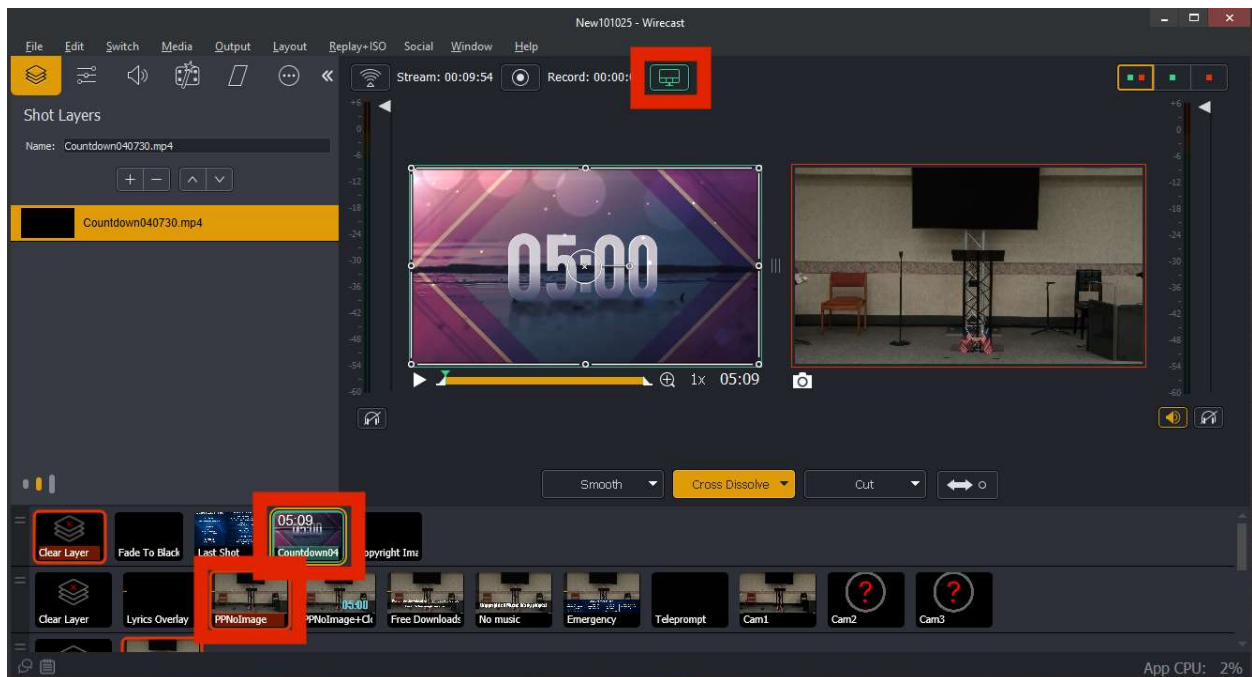
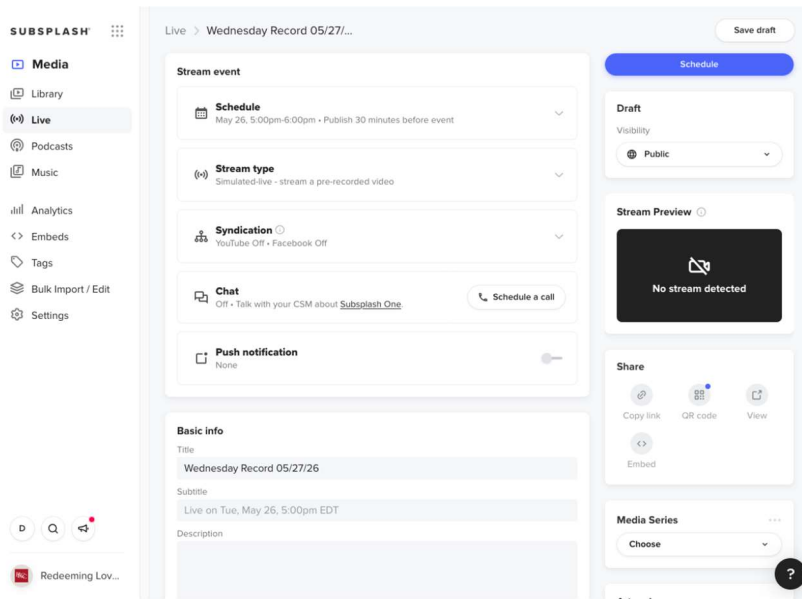


# Streaming With WireCast and Subsplash For Recording

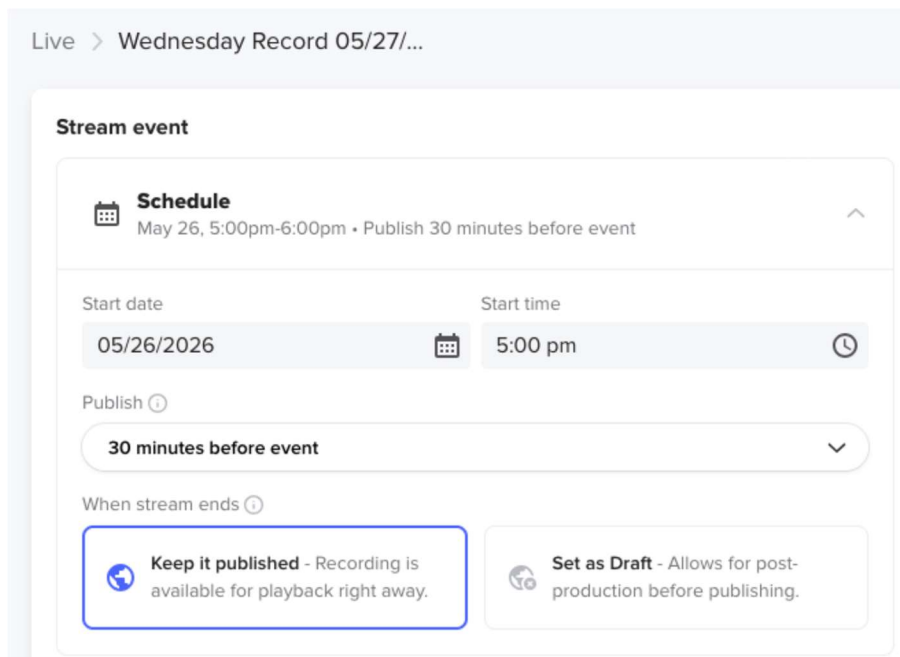
- 1) If WireCast is open, **exit (close) WireCast.**
- 2) **Open (reopen) WireCast** to set defaults.
- 3) In WireCast, set proper shots (**PPNoImage, Countdown040730.mp4**) and select the **Monitor Configuration Button** to display screens in room.



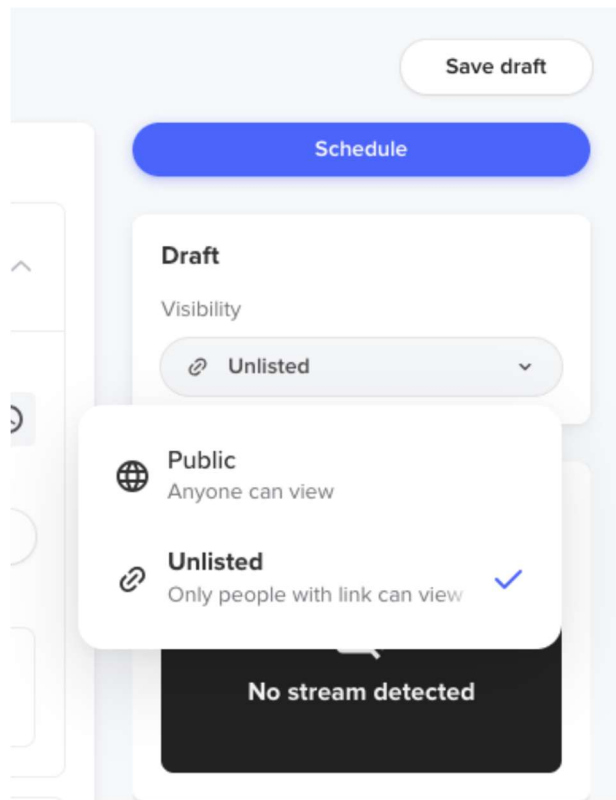
4) In SubSplash (**Media>Live**), create a new Live Stream (**Create Live Stream** button). Name the stream **Wednesday Recording MM/DD/YY**



5) For **Schedule**, set the date and time that the recording stream will begin.



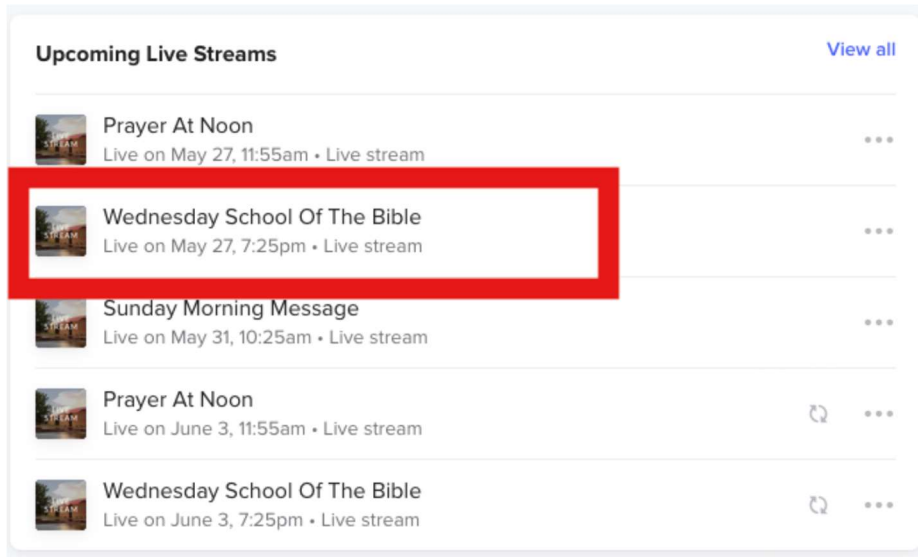
6) In the **Draft** area, set the visibility to **Unlisted**. Click the **Schedule** button.



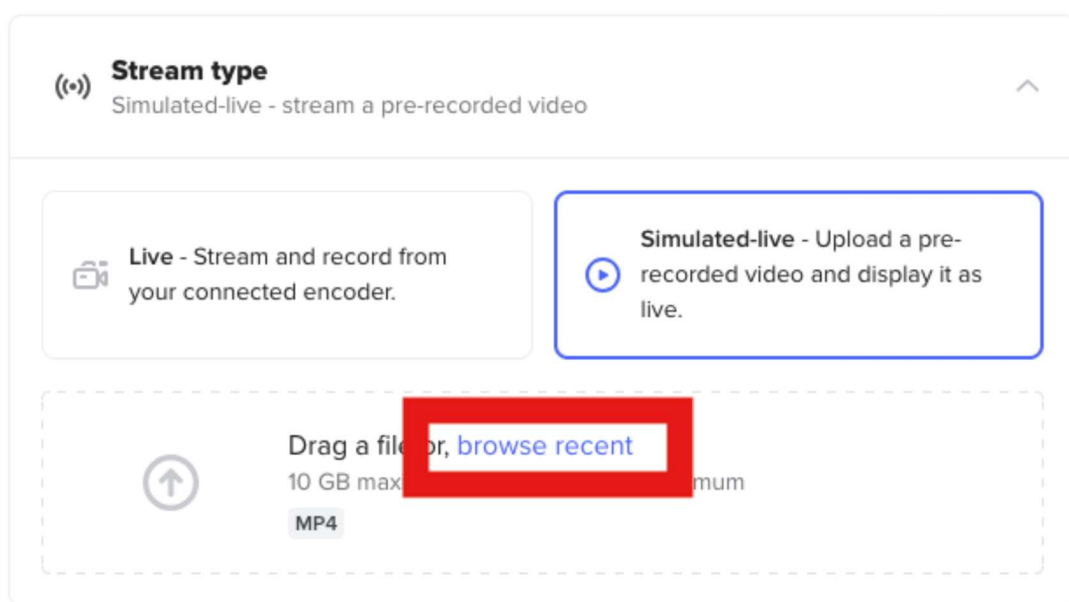
7) At the determined time, **start the stream**.

8) **After the stream/recording has ended**, wait 20-30 minutes.

9) Edit the upcoming live stream. Update the **Title**, **Description** and **Tags (Speaker and Topics)**.



10) Under **Stream Type**, select **Simulated-live**.

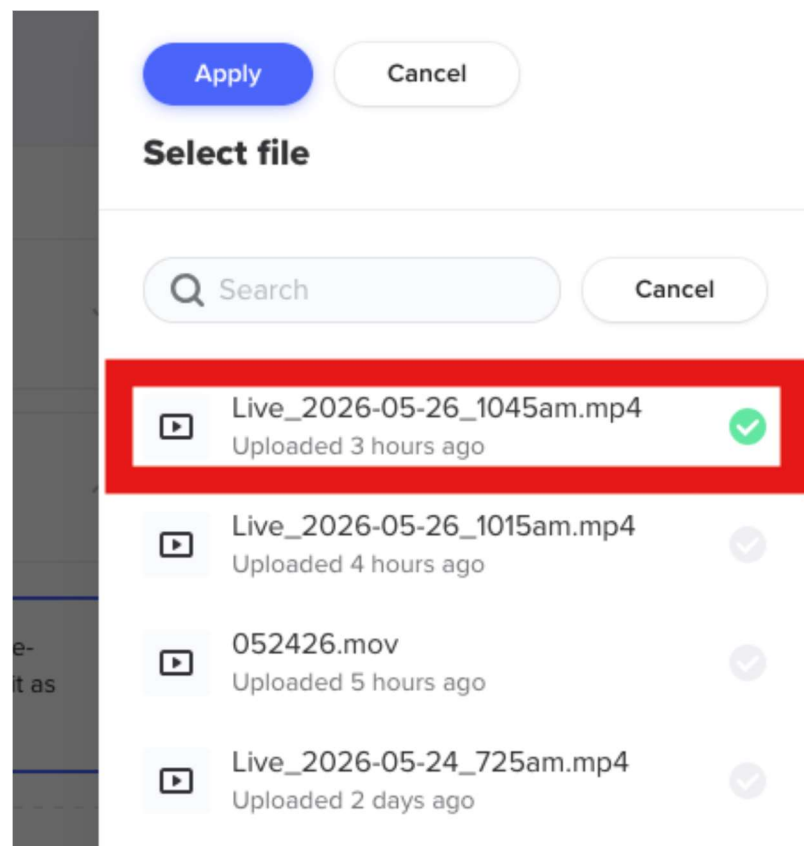


11) Select **browse recent**.

- 12) Under **Select file**, the recording should be the most recent (uppermost) file in the list. The name format for the file will be based upon the start time of the recording:

**Live\_YYYY\_MM\_DD\_HHMM.mp4**

The hour and minutes will be in West Coast time, **3 hours earlier** than the observed record time.




Select the file and click the **Apply** button.

13) **Save** the changes.

**Stream type** Simulated-live - stream a pre-recorded video

**Live** - Stream and record from your connected encoder.

**Simulated-live** - Upload a pre-recorded video and display it as live.
