The Seder includes a full meal, and the program will take approximately two hours from start to finish. The Seder meal is a family-friendly event and includes activities specifically for the children, so bring the whole family! We will be observing this unique meal on Wednesday, **April 1** (appetizers at 5:30 pm and Seder to begin at 6 pm). The last day to reserve your seat is Sunday, **March 8**.
