

VBS Prayer Guide

Sunday - Pray for the Children

Ask God to prepare the hearts of every child who will attend VBS. Pray that they would hear and understand the gospel and grow in their love for Jesus.

Monday - Pray for Safety

Pray for God's protection over every child, volunteer, and family. Ask for safety in travel, activities, and throughout each day of VBS.

Tuesday - Pray for the Volunteers

Pray that God would strengthen and encourage every teacher, leader, helper, and volunteer. Ask Him to give them joy, patience, wisdom, and opportunities to point children to Christ.

Wednesday - Pray for Gospel Conversations

Pray that children would ask meaningful questions about God and that volunteers would clearly communicate the hope found in Jesus.

Thursday - Pray for Families

Ask God to use VBS to impact entire families. Pray that parents and guardians would be encouraged and that the truths children learn would continue to be discussed at home.

Friday - Pray for Lasting Fruit

Pray that the seeds planted throughout the week would take root. Ask God to continue drawing children to Himself long after VBS ends and to help them become lifelong followers of Christ.

Saturday - Pray Thanksgiving

Thank God for all He accomplished during VBS. Praise Him for every volunteer, every child who attended, every conversation about Jesus, and every life He is continuing to transform.
