

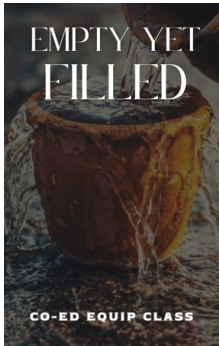

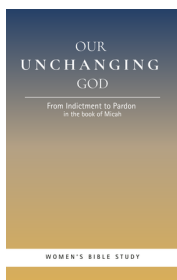
Empty Yet Filled (Co-ed Study)

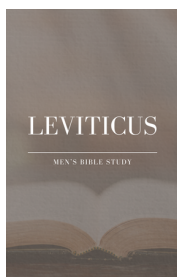


Our Unchanging God: From Indictment to Pardon in the Book of Micah (Women's Study)
