

Titus 10 Men's Study

Purpose

To engage men in our church in interacting with the Scriptures alongside other men on God's model for manhood found in the book of Titus.

When

January 11 - March 16, 2023 (10 weeks)

Wednesday, 6:00 PM in Horne Hall **OR** Thursday, 6:00 AM in G101

Overview

Men of all ages will gather together at their chosen meeting time. Food will be provided before the start time. Men will be invited or assigned to a table with 4-7 other men, including at least one table leader. After a brief *warm-up* time, our pastor Dr. Steven Smith will lead the teaching time. After the teaching, the table leader will facilitate discussion based on the questions provided.

Strategic Points

Table Leaders - These are men whom our pastor has specifically identified and asked to lead a table. Ideally, these would be older men inviting and investing in younger men, as prescribed in the book of Titus. These table leaders are responsible for attending each week, inviting men to join their table, facilitating discussion, and looking for on-ramps to continue mentoring-type relationships with men in our church.

Personal Invite - Table leaders are encouraged to recruit/invite men from our church to form their tables.

Open Invite - Any man is encouraged to be a part. If someone has yet to receive a personal invitation before their chosen meeting time, a table leader will invite them to join their table at that meeting time.

Table Discussion - After the pastor's teaching on Titus each week, group discussion will be facilitated by the table leader. This discussion is vital to helping us learn to implement the principles of biblical manhood.

Older to Younger - Paul prescribes a model for biblical manhood in the book of Titus, where older men invest in younger men.

For Table Leaders...

1. **Identify** - look for men from our church whom you feel the Lord is leading you to include at your table.
2. **Register** - sign up by clicking [here](#).
3. **Invite** - contact 4-6 men to join you at your table at your chosen meeting time; be open to including new men who may attend the day of who do not yet have a table.
4. **Attend** - be present at each session.
5. **Facilitate** - lead the discussion based on the questions provided each week; remain open to expanding the discussion beyond the questions as the Holy Spirit directs.
6. **Follow Up** - periodically reach out to your table members throughout the 10 weeks for accountability and encouragement.

For Attendees...

1. Register - sign up by clicking [here](#).
2. Attend - be present at each session.
3. Engage - be open to the Word and each other around your table.
4. Respond - commit to applying the principles of biblical manhood in your family and our church; look for opportunities with other men and in our city to provide spiritual leadership through the gifts, talents, and abilities that God has uniquely given you.

For Staff Lead...

1. Communicate - contact the table leaders before each meeting.
2. Connect - assure each man in attendance has been assigned to a table, whether through a personal invite or open invite
3. Lead - direct the flow for each meeting time, including warm-up, providing group discussion questions, closing, etc.
4. Follow Up - periodically reach out to table leaders following a meeting to see how things are going.
5. Coordinate - work with pastor, deacons, etc. on developing next steps beyond the Titus study

Meeting Time Template

- **Introduction/Warm Up** (5 minutes) - to get some energy going
- **Prayer** (3 minutes)
- **Teaching** (25 Minutes)
- **Table Discussion** (20 minutes)
- **Closing** (2 minutes)

Meeting Time Checklist

- Room Setup with rounds
- Books onsite to purchase (first 3 weeks)
- Group discussion questions on table
