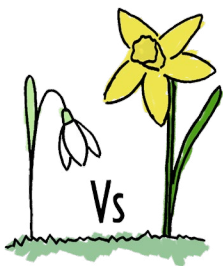


Outdoor EASTER

Have fun and run around a field - enjoy it!

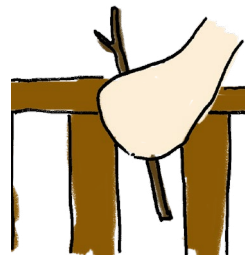
Thank God that through His son, Jesus we have been set free; death's curse has lost its grip on us.

Get messy and make mudcakes - pick some pretty flowers to decorate them with.

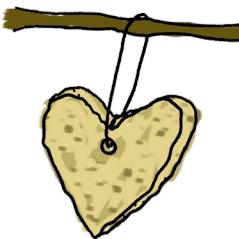
Thank God for this season of new life, growth and the food that we eat.

Invite a friend on a picnic and share food together.

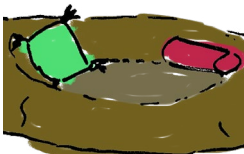
Thank God for the food that we eat and remember how Jesus gathered people together to tell them about who He was.
