

Hey Families! Here's a look at what we're covering with your kids this month so you can continue growing at home during the week.

GROW AT HOME THIS MONTH

WEEK 1

This week, kids hear about the **transfiguration of Jesus** and what the disciples learned from this.

- BIG IDEA: We change when we know who God is.
- BIBLE: Matthew 17:1-9

WEEK 2

This week, kids hear about the conversation between Jesus and the Samaritan woman.

- BIG IDEA: Our past doesn't change God's love for us.
- BIBLE: John 4:5-42

WEEK 3

This week, kids hear about how **Jesus healed a blind** man.

- BIG IDEA: Jesus changes how we see things.
- BIBLE: John 9

WEEK 4

This week, kids hear about the time **Jesus raised** Lazarus from the dead.

- BIG IDEA: Jesus can change anything.
- BIBLE: John 11:1-45

MEMORY VERSE: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" — 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIV)

MEMORY VERSE SIGN LANGUAGE



We all know that strategic hand motions help kids remember what they're learning, but what if you could accomplish even more than simply helping kids remember Scripture? Every Grow Kids memory verse is provided in age-appropriate signs, using a combination of SEE and ASL. Encouraging kids to learn each memory verse in this way will better include kids and families impacted by hearing impairment, and will promote awareness and inclusion for the rest of your kids and families!

This memory verse was translated into sign language and performed by Sunny Brown, a pastor in Atlanta, and ASL interpreter, with an Associates in ASL Interpreting and a Minor in Deaf Studies.



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
