





# GLOSSARY

**Adam** - In the Bible, the first human created by God. His name literally means “humanity”. Adam is seen as a representative of the whole human race, especially in how he fell into sin.

**Amen** - A word at the end of prayers meaning “so be it” or “it is true.”

**Baptism** - A Christian ritual involving water, symbolising cleansing from sin and entry into the Christian family.

**BC (Before Christ)** - A way of dating years before Jesus’ birth.

**Born Again** - Starting a new spiritual life with Jesus.

**Christ / Messiah** - A title for Jesus meaning “King” or “Anointed One.”

**Communion / Eucharist / Lord’s Supper** - Eating bread and wine to remember Jesus’ death.

**Cross / Crucifixion** - The method of execution used by the Romans, where Jesus died. For Christians, it represents Jesus taking on human sin and offering forgiveness.

**Glory** - God’s greatness, beauty, and goodness.

**Gospel** - Means “good news”; also the four New Testament Bible books about Jesus’ life: Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.

**Grace** - God’s undeserved kindness and mercy towards people.

**Incarnation** - God becoming human in Jesus.

**Repentance** - Turning away from wrongdoing and back to God.

**Resurrection** - Jesus rising from the dead.

**Salvation / Saviour** - Being rescued from sin and death; Jesus as the rescuer.

**Sin** - Human selfishness and wrong that separates us from God.

**The Fall** - When Adam and Eve disobeyed God, bringing sin into the world.

**The Trinity** - God as Father, Son (Jesus), and Holy Spirit — three in one.
