

What to Bring

Here are some things to remember as you pack your stuff to come to Camp Outreach. In all things, remember that this is a Christian event. Please bring your favorite Bible, and remember to send some prayers in advance.



Clothing:

Out of respect for others, and in accordance with our Christian standards, all clothing should be modest.

- If you have Camp Outreach t-shirts from previous years – bring them!
- Old work clothes (They will likely be ruined!)
- **Note:** If you do not already have one, you will be provided with a “Camp Outreach” work t-shirt, which you will wear every day on the job sites. T-shirts will be collected and washed each day – we have extra t-shirts to wear each day while dirty ones are being washed.)
- Comfortable casual wear for evenings
- Church clothes - nice casual and appropriate shoes
- **Something to wear to the dance – dressy casual is fine.**
- Comfortable work shoes/boots.
- Swimwear (Note that the pool requires actual swimwear, and not cut-offs, etc.)

Toiletries:

- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Insect repellent
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Soap
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Deodorant
- Comb or brush

Bedding and Linens: A change: sheets, a pillow + pillowcase, blanket, and 2 towels WILL be provided. If you want an extra blanket, towels, washcloths, etc., feel free to bring more.

Water Bottle

Everyone should bring a refillable water bottle. Please label it with your name.

Miscellaneous:

- Games - please feel free to bring things like tools, football, Frisbee, cards and other games plus any extra drinks and snacks you would like – but there is no kitchen to keep drinks cool – ice is available.
