DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES/ACTIVITIES

What follows is a list of classes/activities and a brief description of what we would like to achieve in each one; however, teachers (co-op parents/guardians) who volunteer to take a class/activity have a certain latitude in how they choose to accomplish the goals that are set forth in each class/activity that is listed below.

Devotional Time

Each week, families will take turns leading our devotional time where we will highlight character traits that show godliness. This devotional time will be as unique as each family desires to make it! We hope to sing songs, learn from God's Word, memorize verses, and make applications as to how we can live in light of the character God wants to develop in each of our lives.

Family Showcase

The word showcase(n) means: *a place where the best qualities or parts of something are witnessed*. Our Family Showcase is a time when your children will be able to showcase what they have been learning. It is an opportunity for children to gain life skills from time spent in front of an audience. Children will be asked to participate in a presentation, and/or if time allows, children may spontaneously volunteer to showcase what they have been learning, all within a structured environment. Ideas will be provided for how to use this time, but what children show, sing, recite, share, read, dramatize, report, etc.

PE/Health/Safety

While we love the idea that this will be a space where children may play games and be active, there is more to this class than merely a social playtime. The purpose of these classes is two-fold: 1) to give instruction that pertains to the physical body, educating children as to how God designed the body, how it functions best, and how to care for it; and 2) to teach rules and skills that are specific to certain sports in order to help children understand specific games and enable them to play together in an organized manner that will promote teamwork and good sportsmanship.

Art

This is a class specifically designed for our students with the goal of teaching them how to recognize famous artistic works and implement the artistic styles of famous artists. The purpose of this class is to deepen an understanding of color, form/shape, lines, space, and texture in ways that allow children to not only recognize an artist's work, but to appreciate the nuance of a particular style and using that information, they will then attempt works of art that are their own.

Reading, KidWriting, and Writing

KidWriting is a writing program for emergent writers and early writers. For some, early writing may be a single word or a short sentence, and for others it may be a full paragraph or longer story, but we know that all students can progress in their ability to write well. We will encourage the use of phonetics and correct spelling, but the real purpose is to increase a student's writing ability and create excitement for students to want to write more! The purpose of a writing class for older students is to provide unique and creative ideas that will inspire children to write more, while encouraging correct grammar skills and sentence structure at their learning level.

HISTORY / GEOGRAPHY

STEM

STEM is a way to integrate Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics in a wholistic approach with the purpose of utilizing critical thinking skills in a fun and creative space. The purpose of this class will be to learn how to solve problems after being taught certain data necessary to achieve solutions. We want to give students knowledge and then provide them with the ability to apply that knowledge in real life applications.
